- Mario Sazo also gave Curriculum & Instruction Updates, which included ETS Criterion Online Writing, Lexia English, and NWEA Winter Testing.
 - ETS: Web based instructional writing tool that helps students, plan, write, and revise their essay guided by instant feedback
 - Lexia: Learning program that supports emergent bilingual students' English language acquisition through academic conversations
 - NWEA: Students will be testing their writing, reading, and math skills, which allow us to track learning and progress.

VI. Principal Updates: Facilitated by Principal, Naomi Lara

- Springpoint Visit: 2 day visit to inform a school's approach to ongoing design and iteration work using evidence based feedback. The process includes school leader interview, review of student work with school leaders and the instructional team, classroom walkthroughs, student and staff panels, and an observation activity. Springpoint will be visiting APCH and Richstone on Wednesday, March 28th.
- WASC Updates: WASC Updates and Stakeholder engagement include discussion on attendance and academic data. We will be discussing Student Support Services data on Friday, March 24th. After Spring Break, we will be reviewing our instructional program.
- Stakeholder Engagement: This is our highest priority. Some ideas that the SSC Members discussed include, coffee with the Principal, parent engagement nights, teacher meet and greets, and have each staff member reach out to one stakeholder.
